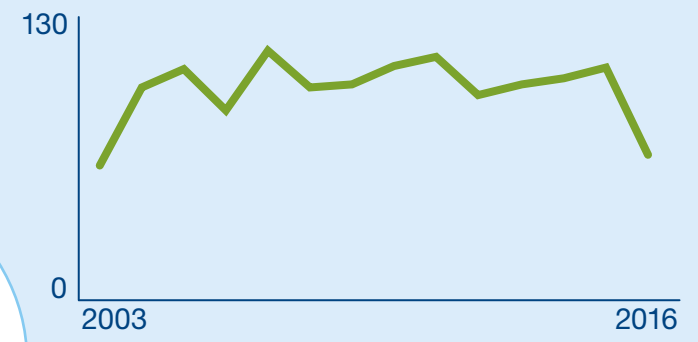


HIV infection in Scotland - 2016.

Reported infections in 15 to 24-year olds in Scotland are at the **lowest level** since **1995**; **infections** in those aged **over 45** are at the **highest ever** for this age group

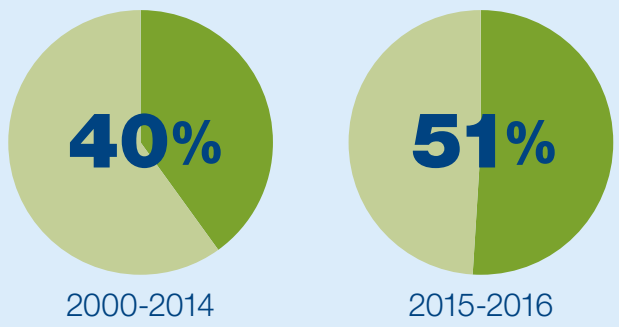


The annual number of reports among **MSM** who likely became **infected in Scotland** fell to its **lowest level since 2003**



285
 There were **285** cases of HIV reported in 2016: **66%** were **new or first time** diagnoses

The **proportion of newly reported cases** presumed to have been **infected in Scotland** has **risen** since 2014



4575 people are **attending for specialist care**, with **95%** receiving **ART** (of whom **97%** are recording a **'manageable' viral load**)
