


HIV infection in Scotland - 2016.








The proportion of newly reported cases presumed to have been infected in Scotland has risen since 2014



The annual number of reports among **MSM** who likely became **infected in Scotland fell** to its **lowest level since 2003**



There were **285** cases of HIV **reported** in 2016: **66%** were **new or first time** diagnoses

4575 people are attending for specialist care, with 95% receiving ART (of whom 97% are recording a 'manageable' viral load)
